TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM-PLUS-FOSTER CARE (THPP-NMD)

Who Qualifies for THPP-NMD Services?

- Non-Minor Dependents (i.e. youth who were in court-ordered, out-of-home placement at age 18 and remain under the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court as adults)
- Ages 18 to 21 years old
- Pursuing the Goals of a current County-approved Transitional Independent Living Plan (TILP).

What is THPP-NMD

- Apartment Housing at Single Site (Resident Advisors reside on site), Remote Site (no staff resides on site), and Host Family (with permanent and supportive connection) locations.
- Comprehensive Supportive Services:
 - Allowance to pay rent, purchase food, bus pass and other necessities
 - Apartment Furnishings
 - Assistance with Transition Plan
 - Case Management
 - Educational/Employment Support
 - Links to Individual/Group Therapy
 - o Mentoring

- Referrals to Community Resources
- Support to build "Permanent Connections" with Family/Community
- 24-Hour Crisis Intervention
- o Pregnancy/Parenting Services
- Emancipation Savings Account
- After-care Services
- **<u>Program Goal:</u>** Each participant makes progress towards his or her life goals, including educational attainment or employment achievement, physical and mental well-being, and connections to community and transitions to secure and stable housing at program completion.

Referral Process:

- 1. Youth and EFC Social Worker Complete and Submit Referral Form. If form is not complete, it will be returned. Current TILP must be uploaded to ETO and demographic page must be current

- 3. Referral will be processed and forwarded to the appropriate THPP-NMD Provider(s).
- 4. Provider(s) will contact the youth and/or EFC social worker to arrange interview. EFC social worker is encouraged to participate in first intake interview. Provider will notify both the County and youth when youth is accepted into the program.
